In light of the recent announcement by Farm & Food Care Canada that it will be transitioning to become the Canadian Centre for Food Integrity, we wish to reassure our members that Farm & Food Care Ontario's mandate, status, board of directors and budget remain separate and unchanged.

Both Farm & Food Care Ontario and Farm & Food Care Saskatchewan will continue to deliver programing specific to their respective provinces. The two provincial organizations will also share management of Farm & Food Care's popular suite of social media platforms.

Award-winning initiatives originally developed by Farm & Food Care Ontario (and its predecessor organizations) - including *The Real Dirt on Farming*, FarmFood360, Ontario's Harvest Gala, and *Faces of Farming* specifically – will return to the ownership of Farm & Food Care Ontario.

Our organization is always seeking input from members as we emphasize our role of earning public trust and confidence in food and farming in Ontario.
