

## TIMING MATTERS:

# STRATEGIES TO AVOID WINTER SPREADING



### **STORAGE**

Consider building more storage capacity to accommodate a higher volume of manure.

### **COVER STORAGE**

Cover manure storage to prevent the accumulation of precipitation and increase the effective capacity.



### **CROP ROTATION**

Diversify crop rotation to increase application windows and allow for manure application in growing crops.

### **MANURE EQUIPMENT**

Use new or modified manure application equipment that allows manure to be applied to growing crops.



### **TEMPORARY IN-FIELD STORAGE**

Consider in-field storage for solid manure in a low-risk location during the winter months.

### **SELL OR SHARE MANURE**

Share or sell manure to neighbours through a manure exchange. A Manure Application Agreement is a way to handle manure without land purchase.
