Speak Up Training (half day, full day and virtual/abbreviated two hour) sessions available (Up to 50 people)	The Speak Up program was developed more than 20 years ago in Ontario and has now expanded across Canada. The training gives participants the ability to tell their stories in an easy-to-understand and compelling manner. This could be of use in farm tours or presentations to political leaders, service clubs, school groups and more. Media Training (full day and virtual/abbreviated two hour sessions available). Livestock Emergency Training (Livestock Truck Rollover): Transport accidents involving livestock trailers present unique challenges for first responders like police or firefighters. Animals that are injured, trapped or loose as the result of a vehicular accident require special consideration for the safety of all concerned. Experience has shown that responders who have had livestock emergency training can more confidently respond to these situations, working in an organized and safe manner while minimizing the overall time on scene. This course will cover trailer design and the implications for extrication points, animal behaviour, incident command related to this unique situation, euthanasia protocols, and how to develop pre-planning documents using provided templates. This course is delivered by large animal rescue expert, Victor MacPherson, and is especially designed for first responders and emergency personnel.
