**May 27, 2022** – On June 4, 2022, *Breakfast from the Farm* will be hosted by Farm & Food Care Ontario (FFCO) and local farmers at the Paris Fairgrounds in Paris, Ontario. Local media are invited and encouraged to attend.

This family-friendly event, held to launch Ontario Local Food Week (June 4 – 10), will provide a unique opportunity for farmers and non-farming Ontarians to walk through exhibits of farm animals and equipment. It gives visitors the chance to have a conversation about food and farming and have their questions answered by real farmers.

Each carload of guests will also receive a bag of breakfast ingredients including pancake mix, eggs, maple syrup, milk, butter, cheese, vegetables and more.

Since 2013, farm families across Ontario have opened their farms to host Breakfast from the Farm events. These popular events have attracted thousands of urban and suburban visitors to local farms across the province. FFCO hosted three drive-through events in 2021 that met all COVID-19 safety guidelines. In 2022 the event will be walkable with displays, livestock and farmers on site to answer guest's questions. The Paris event is the first of three events FFCO will host with Fair partners this season.

Breakfast from the Farm is made possible with co-host Paris Agricultural Society and the support of local agri-businesses and organizations.
