Since 2013, farm families across Ontario have opened their farms to host Breakfast from the Farm events. These popular experiences have attracted thousands of urban and suburban visitors to local farms across the province. FFCO hosted three drive-through events in 2021 that met all COVID-19 safety guidelines. In Elora, the event will be walkable with displays, livestock and farmers on site to answer guest's questions. This event is the second of three events FFCO will host with Fair partners this season.
